Re: December 2015 Consumption Tax Report

Attached is the City of Aspen's monthly report for consumption based tax collections. This report includes analysis of the City's sales tax and lodging tax collections for December 2015, Aspen's portion of Pitkin County's 3.6% sales tax collections for November 2015, and real estate transfer tax (RETT) collections for January 2016.

December's retail sales were up 9% relative to the same period in 2014. Industries posting the largest monthly gains were Automobile, Luxury Goods, Liquor and Marijuana and Construction with 72%, 47%, 25% and 25% increases, respectively. The industries experiencing the largest declines relative to December 2014 were Miscellaneous, General Retail and Clothing which contracted 19%, 12% and 3%, respectively. December generally accounts for roughly 15% of the entire year's sales and collections.

Lodging tax collections were up 17% from the same period last year. On a year-to-date basis, lodging tax collections are up 11% relative to 2014. Annual collections are in line with taxable sales for the accommodation industry, which are up 9% for the year relative to 2014, but vary for the month of December due to less on-site, non-room sales.

Aspen's portion of Pitkin County's sales tax collections for November 2015 (one month behind city collection statistics because they are collected at the State level) were up 33% from the same period in 2014, as last year's monthly collections were low relative to historical collections for the month. On a year-to-date basis, tax revenue is up 9% relative to 2014.

Housing and Wheeler real estate transfer tax collections for January 2016 were down 69% and 67%, respectively, as January 2015 included greater volume and larger individual sales last year.

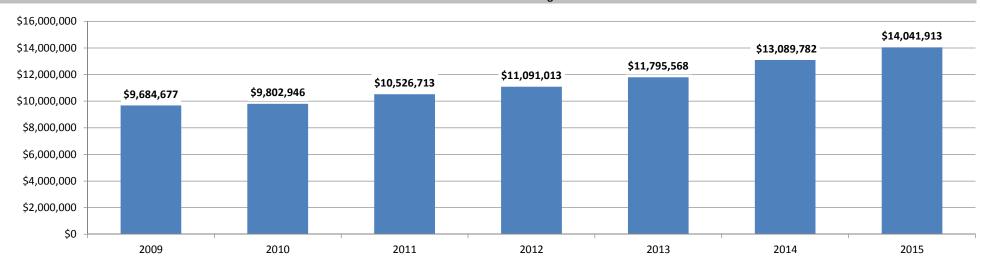

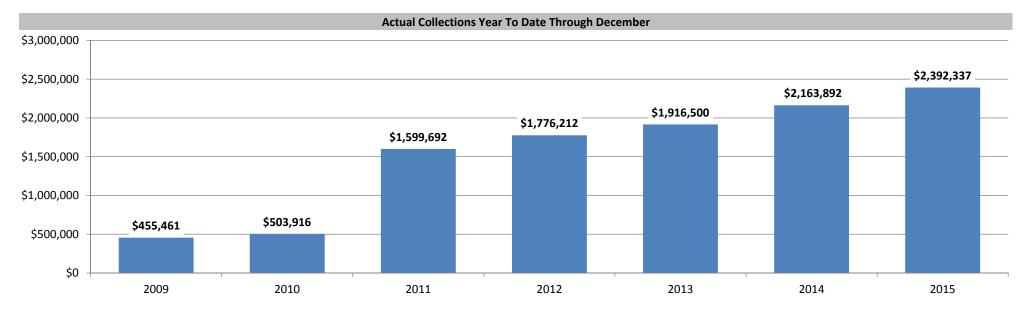

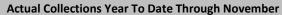
City of Aspen Portion of Pitkin County 3.6% Sales Tax November 2015

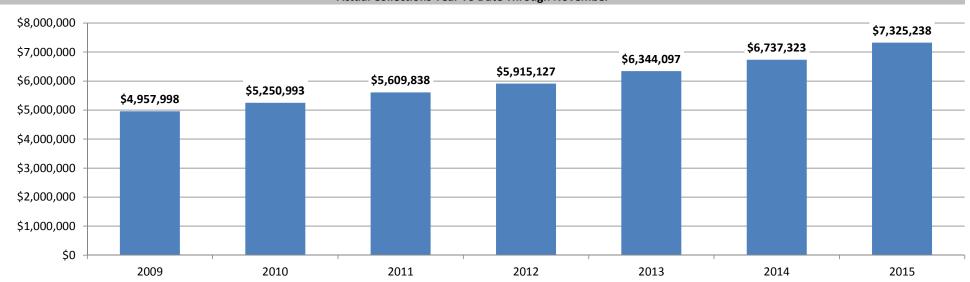

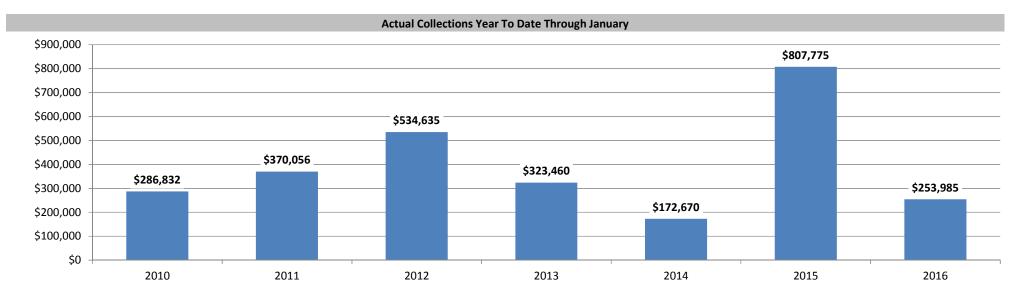
