Re: <u>UPDATED</u> February 2016 Consumption Tax Report

Attached is the City of Aspen's monthly report for consumption based tax collections. This report includes analysis of the City's sales tax and lodging tax collections for February 2016, Aspen's portion of Pitkin County's 3.6% sales tax collections for January 2016, and real estate transfer tax (RETT) collections for March 2016.

February's retail sales were up 5% relative to the same period in 2015. Industries posting the largest monthly gains were Miscellaneous, General Retail, and Liquor and Marijuana with 20%, 18%, and 17%, respectively. The industries experiencing the largest declines relative to February 2015 were Luxury Goods, Clothing, and Sports Equipment/Clothing which contracted 23%, 1% and 1%, respectively. February generally accounts for roughly 11% of the entire year's sales and collections. Similar to last month, late filings for December 2015 and January 2016 added to February tax revenue, adding roughly \$17,200 in collections whereas the associated taxable sales are posted back to the applicable months. As such, there is a disparity between industry taxable sales growth and net tax collected for February.

Lodging tax collections were up 7% from the same period last year. On an annual basis, lodging tax collections are 3% above prior year collections through February. As noted in last month's report, the variance between tax collections and accommodation industry taxable sales is due to on-site non-room sales (which are included in the taxable sales for accommodations) declining substantially from January 2015 to January 2016.

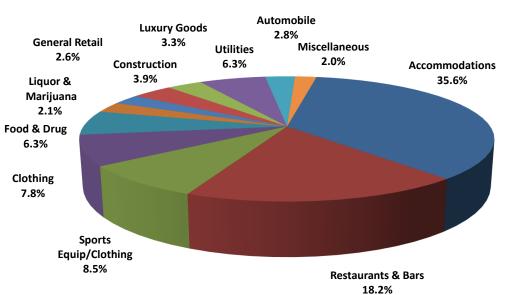
Aspen's portion of Pitkin County's sales tax collections for January 2016 (one month behind city collection statistics because they are collected at the State level) were down 2% from the same period in 2015.

Housing and Wheeler real estate transfer tax collections for March 2016 were down 53% and 52%, respectively. On an annual basis, collections for real estate transfer taxes are tracking 60% and 63% behind last year's figures to date.

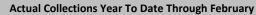

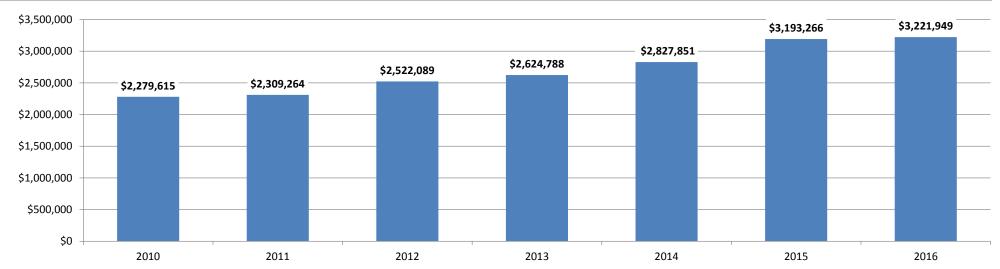

City of Aspen Tourist Promotion 1.5% Lodging Tax (0.5% Rate for 2010 and Prior) February 2016

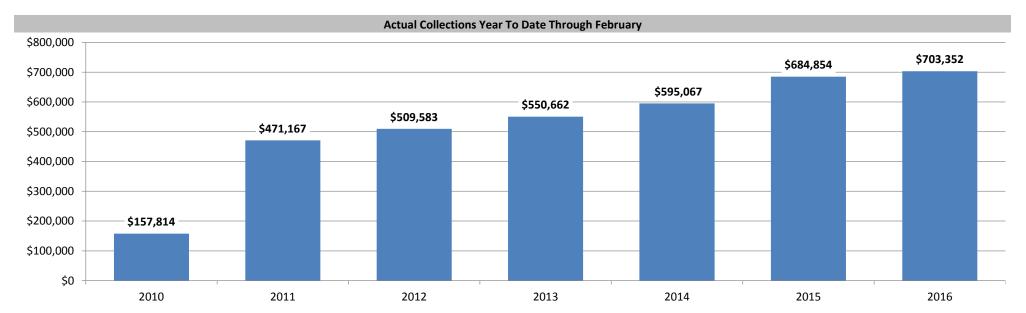

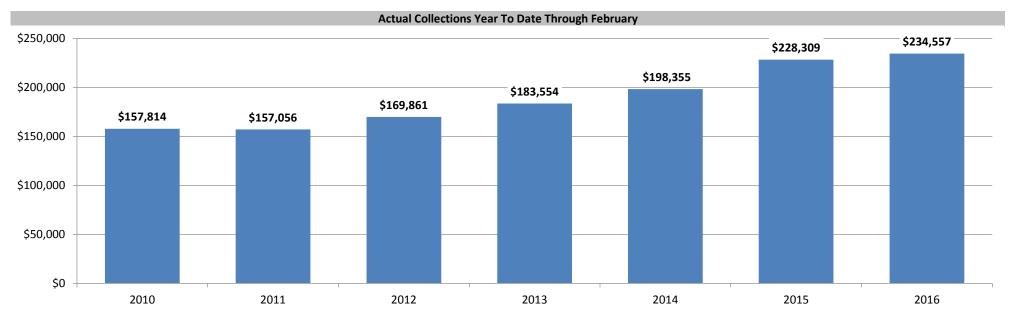

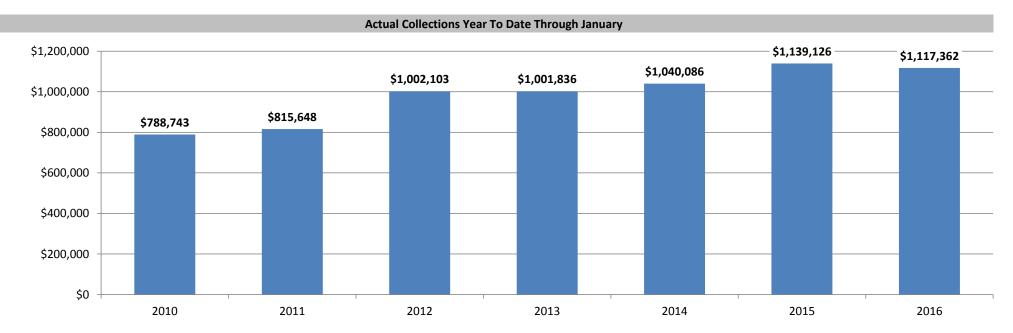
City of Aspen Portion of Pitkin County 3.6% Sales Tax January 2016

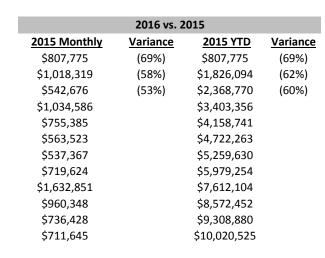

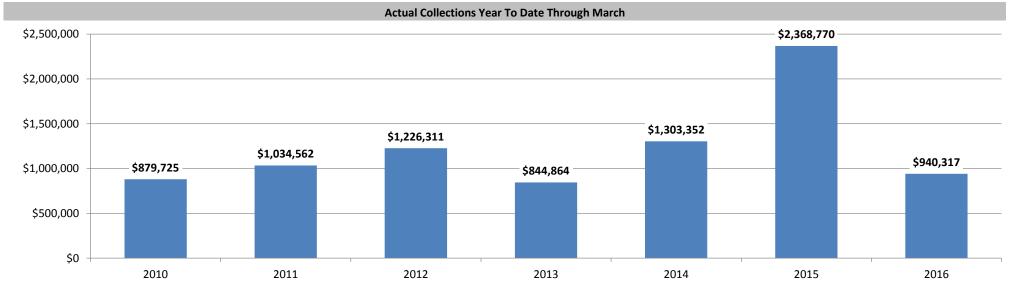
