Re: January 2016 Consumption Tax Report

Attached is the City of Aspen's monthly report for consumption based tax collections. This report includes analysis of the City's sales tax and lodging tax collections for January 2016, Aspen's portion of Pitkin County's 3.6% sales tax collections for December 2015, and real estate transfer tax (RETT) collections for February 2016.

January's retail sales were down 5% relative to the same period in 2015. Industries posting the largest monthly gains were Construction, Liquor and Marijuana, General Retail and Miscellaneous Retail with 19%, 11%, 8% and 8% increases, respectively. The industries experiencing the largest declines relative to January 2015 were Luxury Goods, Automobiles, and Clothing which contracted 39%, 17% and 12%, respectively. January generally accounts for roughly 11% of the entire year's sales and collections. Due to a number of large late filings for December 2015 and the City's cash basis of accounting for revenues, January 2016 collections reflect a 1% increase relative to January 2015.

Lodging tax collections were down 1% from the same period last year and varies from the 6% decline in taxable sales for the accommodations industry. This variance is due to on-site non-room sales (which is included in the taxable sales for accommodations) declining substantially from January 2015 to January 2016.

Aspen's portion of Pitkin County's sales tax collections for December 2015 (one month behind city collection statistics because they are collected at the State level) were up 3% from the same period in 2014. For the year, 2015 tax revenue ended up 8% relative to 2014.

Housing and Wheeler real estate transfer tax collections for February 2016 were down 65% and 72%, respectively. On an annual basis, collections for real estate transfer taxes are tracking 67% and 70% behind last year's figures to date.






City of Aspen Transportation 0.5% Lodging Tax January 2016



City of Aspen Portion of Pitkin County 3.6% Sales Tax December 2015






